2023-24 Aid Information/Instructions for Post-bachelor Students

Financial aid eligibility criteria

To receive financial aid, you must be a regular student in an eligible program at Wayne State University **and** submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

 An eligible academic program leads to a degree or certificate. Note: Not all certificates are eligible for federal student aid. A list of financial aid eligible certificates is on the Office of Student Financial Aid website at wayne.edu/financial-aid/applying/certificate.

Financial aid eligibility exception

An exception to the eligible program requirement is enrollment in courses that are prerequisite requirements for full admission to an undergraduate, graduate, or professional program. We will only provide aid for students entering programs at WSU.

Your advisor must certify that you will be eligible to be admitted to the program upon successful completion of the required prerequisite courses. You will not be eligible for financial aid if you will not be enrolled in the new program.

Courses that do not qualify for financial aid:

- Courses taken for the sole purpose of raising your grade point average or to correct an educational deficiency, courses that are not required prerequisites for enrollment in an eligible program.
- Courses taken for professional recognition or advancement or that are recommended, but not required.

You must enroll *only* in courses that are required for admission and enrollment in an undergraduate, graduate, or professional academic program.

Do not assume you will receive financial aid. A Financial Aid Officer must review your forms and enrollment status to confirm your aid eligibility.

Loan limitations

You must be enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) to be eligible for federal student loans. Preparatory coursework for admission to an undergraduate program —

Dependent students: \$2,625Independent students: \$8,625

Preparatory coursework for admission to a graduate program -

Dependent students: \$5,500Independent students: \$12,500

All loans borrowed at the undergraduate level are included in calculating your eligibility. Review your loan history at studentaid.gov.

Aggregate loan limits:

- Dependent Students \$31,000, of which no more than \$23,000 can be subsidized loans
- Independent Students \$57,500, of which no more than \$23,000 can be subsidized loans

Loan time limit

Loans—Federal Direct Loan or Federal Parent PLUS Loan—are limited to **one consecutive 12-month period**, i.e., three consecutive semesters: fall, winter, and summer; OR winter, summer, and fall; OR summer, fall, and winter. Federal financial aid regulations do not allow exceptions.
