If you have an SSN, you must file the 2024-25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at studentaid.gov/fafsa.

If you have a_Social Security Number (SSN) but your parents do not, they will be able to create a <u>studentaid.gov</u> account to access their portion of the FAFSA.

If you file the FAFSA online, you do not need to submit this form.

Eligibility requirements:

- Live in the city of Detroit (verified by mailing address) and graduate from high school in 2020 or after, OR
 graduate from any <u>Detroit high school</u> (public, private, charter, parochial, home school or GED program) in 2020 or after
- Be admitted to Wayne State University as a first-time, full-time freshman in fall 2024.
- WSU must receive your 2024-25 FAFSA by April 1, 2024.
- Must be admitted to WSU by April 1, 2024.
- Awards will be given until funding is exhausted.

Continued eligibility requirements:

- Meet all <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u> requirements.
- Maintain full-time enrollment (12 or more credit hours each semester) during the fall and winter semesters.
- Pass at least 30 credits per academic year.
- Submit an updated FAFSA by August 1 for the next academic year.
