The Critical Analysis and Reasoning Section (CARS) of the MCAT assesses **foundations of comprehension** (skill 1), **reasoning within the text** (*skill 2*) and **reasoning beyond the test** (*skill 3*). It is critical that premed students develop these three skills with the same focus and determination that they use when approaching science content.

The classes below have all been evaluated for their development of this skill set. Pre-med students may choose to incorporate them into their general education requirements or take them as electives.
