

Suggested PreDental Minors

A minor can be an excellent way to maximize your coursework and add interest to your undergraduate studies and resume. Here are some popular and helpful suggestions for minors that work well within the recommended pre-dental courses.

Biology minor (21 – 23 credits) (BIO)

- 1500 + 1510(LS) (8 credits total)
- 2600 or 2200 (3 or 4 credits)
- 3100 or 3200 (3 credits each)
- 3070 (4 credits)
- 4200 (3 credits)

Business minor (18 credits)

- ACC 3010 (3 credits)
- FIN 3290 (3 credits)
- MGT 2530 (3 credits)
- MKT 2300 (3 credits)
- Two elective courses that fall in the School of Business curriculum (6 credits total)
- **Many of the business courses do require prerequisite coursework

Chemistry minor (29 credits) (CHM)

- 1220/30 (PS) (5 credits)
- 1240/50 (5 credits)
- 2220/30 (5 credits)
- 2289/90 (5 credits)
- 3000 (3 credits)
- 5600 + one of the following: 6635, 6640 or 6270 (6 credits total)

Or

• 6620+6640 (6 credits total)

Public Health minor (20-22 credits) (PH)

- PH 2100 (3 credits)
- PH 3100 (3 credits)
- PH 3200 (4 credits)
- PH 3300 (4 credits)
- Minimum of TWO elective course (see list of course choices at clas.wayne.edu/public-health)

Psychology minor (18 credits) (PSY)

- PSY 1010(LS) or 1020(LS) (4 and 3 credits, respectively)
- At least 3 courses must be taken at WSU
