

Reflect

Reports can help us reflect on and improve the classroom tools and strategies that facilitate student success. In reflecting on your report, you might consider the **3 C's**:

- **Context**: What was going on that semester in the university? In the world?
- **Change**: Did you implement anything new that semester?
- Challenges: Were there any roadblocks for students that you noticed throughout the semester?

You might also consider learning outcomes as individual units and in relation to each other.
