

General Education Program Assessment Gen Ed Designation: Social Inquiry (SI) Institutional Report Fall 2019-Winter 2020

Purpose and Process

To ensure that students are obtaining the intended outcomes of the General Education program, the General Education Oversight Committee (GEOC) has established an assessment plan for the program. Each year, instructors teaching courses in a subset of Gen Ed designations are responsible for choosing at least one assignment from their course, scoring it using the relevant Gen Ed rubric(s) for the course's designation(s), and submitting those scores to the GEOC. The designations scheduled for assessment in 2019-2020 were Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI), Quantitative Experience (QE), and Social Inquiry (SI). Once scores are submitted, the Office of Institutional Research and Analysis analyzes and disseminates the results according to GEOC guidelines.

This report presents aggregated data from all Social Inquiry (SI) courses offered from Fall 2019-Winter 2020 in two formats: table and graph. The SI rubric, which defines the performance levels, and more information about Gen Ed assessment are online at https://provost.wayne.edu/gen-ed-assessment. Note that accreditation of the university depends in part on our ability to demonstrate student learning for the Gen Ed learning outcomes.

Please note that the Covid-19 pandemic forced a sudden move to remote teaching and learning in Winter 2020. Results should therefore be interpreted with that context in mind.

How GEOC can use this information

GEOC can use assessment data to understand how well the Gen Ed program is helping students gain the knowledge and skills the program intends to provide. Based on that understanding, GEOC might choose a variety of actions, such as celebrating successes, strategizing ways to better support instructors, improving the program's design, or arguing for resources to enhance the program. Colleges/schools, departments/programs, and instructors are also encouraged to use the assessment results to strengthen the Gen Ed program.



The table includes the number of scores (N) submitted, the average score (mean [Mn]), standard deviation of scores from the mean (SD) and the percentage of students achieving each performance level for each learning outcome individually and a grand total for the Gen Ed designation.
