Leave of Absence Information for Financial Aid Recipients - MD Program

The WSU School of Medicine (SOM) Office of Student Affairs administers the leave of absence (LOA) procedures for students in the MD program.

For financial aid purposes every leave of absence is considered a withdrawal effective the first day of the leave.



What you must know before your LOA is approved

Required exit loan counseling

The day the leave of absence for a federal student loan borrower begins, the grace period on each loan begins. Grace periods on federal student loans range between zero and nine months based on the type of loan. Interest on unsubsidized loans will continue to accrue during the grace period. Making interest payments during the grace period can reduce the total loan repayment amount due upon graduation.

Return of federal (Title IV) funds calculation

Every leave of absence is considered a withdrawal effective the first day of the leave.

- Federal financial aid regulations state that a student who stops attending courses at any point prior to completing the payment period or period of enrollment is considered to have withdrawn unless at the time of the withdrawal the school obtains written confirmation from the student that they will attend a module that begins later in the same payment period or period of enrollment. The later module that the student will attend must begin no later than 45 calendar days after the end date of the module that the student stopped attending.
- If you withdraw from all classes, your financial aid may be reduced or canceled. Financial aid reduction or cancellation may create a balance due on your student tuition account that you must pay to Wayne State University.

Tuition adjustment

- If your tuition assessment is adjusted by the SOM Records & Registration Office based on the quantity of courses completed during the academic year, the adjustment may create a credit balance of federal aid.
- With your written authorization, the Office of Student Financial Aid may apply the credit balance to your federal loans thereby reducing your loan debt.
