Purpose of this form:

Federal financial aid regulations state that a student who stops attending courses at any point prior to completing the payment period or period of enrollment is considered to have withdrawn **unless at the time of the withdrawal** the school obtains **written confirmation** from the student that he or she will attend a module that begins later in the same payment period or period of enrollment. The later module that the student will **must** begin no later than 45 calendar days after the end of the module the student stopped attending.

Who should complete this form:

Complete this form if (1) you are receiving financial aid **and** (2) you are withdrawing from all current classes **but** (3) you are registered in a class/classes that begin later this semester.

NOTICE: If you withdraw from **all** classes, your financial aid may be reduced or cancelled. Financial aid reduction or cancellation may create a balance on your student tuition account that you must pay to the University.

- **Academic Record** – Class withdrawals appear on your [academic record](#) and may affect graduate opportunities in the future.
- **Repay** - If you withdraw, you may be required to [repay a portion of your aid](#) back to the university.
- **Time to Degree** - Withdrawing extends the time and cost of your degree.
