Option 1

File the 2021-22 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.gov or through the myStudentAid mobile app.

Option 2

If you don't have a Social Security Number (SSN) you will not be able to complete the FAFSA online and will need to submit a signed [paper FAFSA](#) to our office with this attached cover sheet.

Eligibility requirements:

- Live in the city of Detroit (verified by mailing address) and graduate from high school in 2020 or after OR graduate from any Detroit high school (public, private, charter, parochial, home school or GED program) in 2020 or after.
- Join RaiseMe to earn micro-scholarships by completing student success activities.
- Be admitted to Wayne State University as a first-time, full-time freshman in fall 2020 or after.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by March 1 for the following fall.

Continued eligibility requirements:

- Meet all satisfactory academic progress requirements.
- Maintain full-time enrollment (12 or more credit hours per semester) during the fall and winter semesters.
- Pass at least 30 credits per academic year.
- Submit an updated FAFSA by March 1 for the following fall.
