Eligibility requirements:

- Live in the city of Detroit (verified by mailing address) and graduate from high school in 2020 or after, OR graduate from any Detroit high school (public, private, charter, parochial, home school or GED program) in 2020 or after
- Be admitted to Wayne State University as a first-time, full-time freshman in fall 2024.
- WSU must receive your 2025-26 FAFSA by April 1, 2025.
- Must be admitted to WSU by April 1, 2025.
- Awards will be given until funding is exhausted.

Continued eligibility requirements:

- Meet all Satisfactory Academic Progress requirements.
- Maintain full-time enrollment (12 or more credit hours each semester) during the fall and winter semesters.
- Pass at least 30 credits per academic year.
- Submit an updated FAFSA by August 1 for the next academic year.
