If you have been granted a Total and Permanent Disability (TPD) Discharge you will not be eligible to receive a new Direct Loan, or TEACH Grant unless:

- You obtain a certification from a physician that you are able to engage in substantial gainful activity; and
- You sign a statement acknowledging that the new loan or TEACH Grant service obligation cannot be discharged in the future on the basis of any injury or illness present at the time the new loan or TEACH Grant is made, unless your condition substantially deteriorates so that you are again totally and permanently disabled.

If you are in the process of applying for a TPD; or if you were approved for TPD discharge based on SSA documentation or a physician's certification and during your 3-year post-discharge monitoring period, you request a new Direct Loan or TEACH Grant - you must resume repayment on the previously discharged loans. Contact the <u>TPD Servicer</u> to inform them that you will be receiving a new Title IV loan or TEACH Grant and that your discharged obligations must be reinstated.

### If you do not want to borrow a new loan

- 1. Complete section 1 and return this form to our office.
- 2. You will be considered for other types of financial aid, including federal grants, but will not be able to borrow a new federal student loan or be considered for a TEACH grant.

## If you want to borrow a new loan

- 1. Complete Section 2.
- 2. Ask your physician to complete the Physician's Certification form.
- 3. Return both forms to the Wayne State University Office of Student Financial Aid.

Note: (1) The student must sign the Borrower Acknowledgement Statement each time they receive a new loan after a disability discharge. (2) The Physician's Certification is required only once before the student may borrow new federal student loans after a disability discharge. The school will maintain this certification in the student's file.

# Borrower's Acknowledgment Statement of Ineligibility for Cancellation of Loans

### I acknowledge that:

- 1. I am applying for one or more federal loans or a federal TEACH grant.
- 2. I currently have the ability to engage in substantial gainful activity in order to repay the new loan.
- 3. Any federal loan(s) or TEACH grant that I receive as a result of a physician's certification of my ability to engage in substantial gainful activity **cannot** be discharged based on any present impairment unless that present impairment or conditions deteriorates so that I again meet the definition of having a total and permanent disability; AND
- 4. If I request a new loan during the post-discharge monitoring period or conditional discharge period, I must resume payment on the old loan before receipt of the new loan.
