



Empower Health for Our Urban Neighborhoods

Wayne State plays a vital role in Detroit's health. By unleashing our faculty, students and university leaders to engage even further with our community, we expand cutting-edge care and address entrenched health disparities to build healthier, more resilient neighborhoods in Detroit and beyond.

Community-engaged research: Funded by NIH's National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences, the **Center for Urban Responses to Environmental Stressors** works to understand how exposure to stressors in the urban environment can influence the development of environmentally linked diseases.

Community-immersed care: Affiliated with Nursing Practice Corporation and the College of Nursing, **The Taylor Street Primary Care Clinic** is a full-service, community-focused primary care clinic that treats patients of all ages, many of whom are uninsured.

School of public health initiative: In establishing Michigan's newest community-focused school of public health, Wayne State is addressing urgent workforce needs and reaffirming our commitment to advancing public health for the benefit of our local communities.

Fuel Innovation for Our Competitiveness

By fostering innovation and entrepreneurship, Wayne State is propelling Michigan's competitiveness in 21st century commerce and fostering an "open for business" campus that creates solutions to the challenges endemic to urban areas and ensures a robust economy that benefits us all.

As a top-tier research university, Wayne State supports the discovery of new and unexpected advancements by our faculty and students in areas including neuroscience, maternal health, population health, cancer and policy, and supports our innovators as they transfer that learning into commercially viable medicines, technologies and other solutions.

Much of this is accomplished through **TechTown**, WSU's entrepreneurship and business support hub, which has supported more than **6,000** businesses, created more than **2,200** jobs and raised more than **\$400** million in capital.

WSU is also **one of only 85 universities nationwide** to receive the Association of Public and Land-Grant Universities' prestigious **Innovation and Economic Prosperity designation**, which honors institutions that demonstrate "a substantive commitment to regional economic engagement, growth and economic opportunity."

From pioneering the world's first successful open-heart surgery to launching the nation's first comprehensive electric-drive vehicle engineering program, WSU is on the forefront of pushing boundaries that save lives and change our world.
