

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMINATION CREDIT POLICY

Effective November 2017, there is no limit to the number of credit hours for AP or a combination of AP, IB, CLEP, and department-based credit by examination that may be used toward a WSU degree. All credit will be recorded on the student record.

American Government, American History & Comparative Government - A student may not use both American Government and Comparative Government to satisfy General Education requirements, but credit from both examinations may be used toward graduate hours.

Art Studio: 2-D, 3-D, Drawing - For a score of 3, 4, or 5 Art majors should contact Art Department advisor for portfolio review.

English Literature/Composition or Language/Composition - Credits will be awards for either examination, but not for both.

Caculus AB/BC - A score of 2 to 5 satisfied the MATH COMPETENCY (MC) or QUANTITATIVE EXPERIENCE (QE) General Education requirement. A score of 2, however, is not awarded advanced standing credit. **Physics C: Mechanics & E&M** - No credits are given for score of 3.

Wayne State University does not grant any credit for score of 1 or 2.

ADMINISTRATION OF CREDIT: The College Board sends all scores to the Office of Testing and Evaluation. From there, they are

The College Board also sends copies of the score report to the student and the student's high school. Only official score reports sent directly to Wayne State are considered for credit. Credit is not awarded based on the credit awarded by another institution and placed on that institution's transcript. The student need only request the score be sent to Wayne State, the code is 1898.
