College Algebra - A Student who receives a score of 50 in both College Algebra and College Trigonometry will receive credit for MAT 1800 (5 semester hours) and will have satisfied Math Competency (MC) or Quantitative Experience (QE).

All scale scores for the General Examinations in English Composition, Humanities, Mathematics, Natural Science, and Social Science will be reported as a two-digit number. The score scale for the general exams has switched from 200-800 to 20-80. In addition, the General Examinations are now Subject Examinations based on the College Board's July 2001 revisions.
