Wayne State University General Education Requirements:

All WSU students fulfill the university's general education requirements, which are classes in addition to courses within the students' major that ensure fundamental skills and a well-rounded education. These are as follows:

- BC Basic Composition
- CI Cultural Inquiry
- CIV Civic Literacy Inquiry
- DEI Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Inquiry
- GL Global Learning Inquiry
- ICN Intermediate Composition New (effective Fall 2018)
- NSI Natural Scientific Inquiry
- NSIL Natural Scientific Inquiry with lab
- OC Oral Communication
- QE Quantitative Experience
- SI Social Inquiry

<u>Acceptable Scores</u>: The IB exam score ranges from 1 to 7 with 7 being the highest score. A score of 4 or 5 will yield credit for one course. A score of 6 or 7 will yield credit for two courses **except Chemistry and Mathematics**. <u>The University will only</u> grant credit for exams at the "Higher Level (HL)."

<u>Grantable Credits</u>: The credit granted will be restricted to first year level courses **except for foreign languages**.
