



## Wayne State University (WSU) General Education

One of the main areas of focus for transfer students is the WSU **General Education Requirements**, which are classes in addition to courses within your major that are required to ensure fundamental skills and a well-rounded education. We strongly recommend that all transfer students **fulfill their general education requirements through the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA) before transferring to WSU**. Each community college has an MTA approved course list of its own (see the table below). Upon the completion of the MTA approved list of courses for your school, students will satisfy WSU's General Education Requirements as a block transfer (minimum of 30 credits):

\*\*Once student take all the required courses for MTA at their community college, they can request their community college to stamp "MTA satisfied" on their transcript. If you have any questions, please consult your community college advisor.

### **Direct Course Equivalencies for each general education category (Community College ↔ WSU)**

If students do not take the MTA route, then they are required to adhere to WSU's general education requirement by taking each course under each general education category. We strongly encourage students to take the MTA route because this will save students from taking more credits **in addition** to the 30-credit block required by the MTA.

#### General Education table guidelines:

- Choose **one** from each category **except** for the Natural Scientific Inquiry, which requires **two** courses.
- Courses with an **asterisk (\*)** fall under more than one category, but these courses will fulfill only one category that would benefit the student most.
