### Pre-Medicine/Dentistry Track Pre-Requisite Courses

The courses below represent the required coursework for most US medical and dental schools as well as the recommended courses necessary to prepare for entrance exams. Please note that pre-medicine and pre-dentistry are not actual majors. Pre-health advisors can help you select a major. Medical and dental schools recommend that a portion of these courses be taken at a four year institution. Students considering a transfer are strongly encouraged to attend an Information Session with the Pre-Med and Health Science Center.
