The Addendum reflects updates to the Wayne State University (WSU) degree requirements, including new degree requirements, total degree credits and specific transfer equivalencies for students entering on or after Fall 2020. The following WSU updates are included per this addendum:

- 1) Total credit requirements for B.S. in Computer Science is 120;
- 2) Complete new degree requirements BE 1200 (3 credit hours) and BE 1600 (3 credit hours);
- 3) PRDE 2100 (3 credit hours) will transfer as BE 1200.


