

Transfer Plan for Mott Community College **Pre-Medicine or Pre-Dentistry (Not an actual major – see under pre-requisites)** College of Liberal Arts and Sciences

WSU strongly recommend that all transfer students fulfill their general education requirements through the <u>Michigan</u> <u>Transfer Agreement (MTA)</u> before transferring to WSU.
