Financial Documentation of Support for Canadians



Instructions

This documentation is to be used for Canadian freshmen and university/college undergraduate transfer students who need to complete the Statement of Financial Support and Funding Statement as part of an existing undergraduate admission application.

Resident or commuting Canadian students must provide an official Statement of Financial Support showing the sponsor's willingness to pay for tuition, registration fees, books and supplies, and living expenses (if applicable) for the anticipated study period at Wayne State University.

Your ability or that of your sponsor to provide the needed funds must be verified by a third party such as a bank. Use the enclosed "Funding Statement" form or request a letter from your sponsor's bank indicating the name of the bank, the account number, the account holder's name with signature and the bank official's signature. It is advised that the student request two original copies of financial documents: one for the visa application and one to submit to Wayne State University.

Instructions

Official sponsorship letters including details, terms and amounts of the award must be attached to the Statement of Financial Support. This form must be completed and submitted along with an **original** funding statement or official letter of award from the sponsor as part of the admission process. **Photocopies of the documents are not acceptable**.

The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services regulations require that all international applicants demonstrate their ability to meet all living and educational expenses for the entire intended period of study in order for the university to issue a Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 AB or IAP-66). For this reason, this form must be completed and returned regardless of the source of funding. If the applicant will be supported by personal and/or family funds, the reverse side of this form must be completed.

If the applicant is married and plans to bring the spouse and dependent children to the United States, additional funds are required to cover the expenses for the spouse and children.

The Office of Undergraduate Admissions of Wayne State University will not issue the Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20 AB or IAP-66) until the applicant has received an affirmative admission decision.

If admitted, the applicant will need to prove to the United States Consulate Officer in the home country that there are sufficient funds to cover the first year of study. Therefore, we suggest that you request two original copies of all financial documents: one copy for you to keep and submit to the US Consulate and the other to send to Wayne State with the original application for admission.
